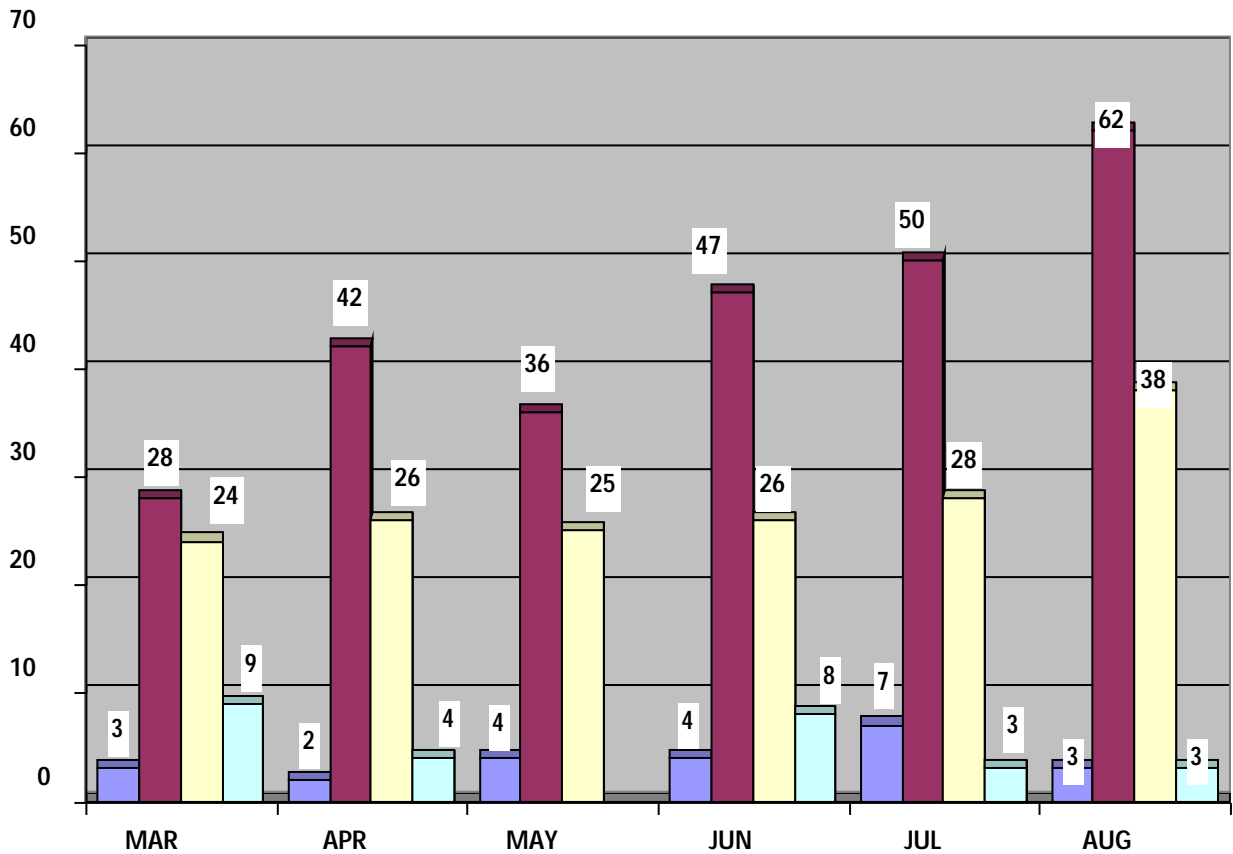

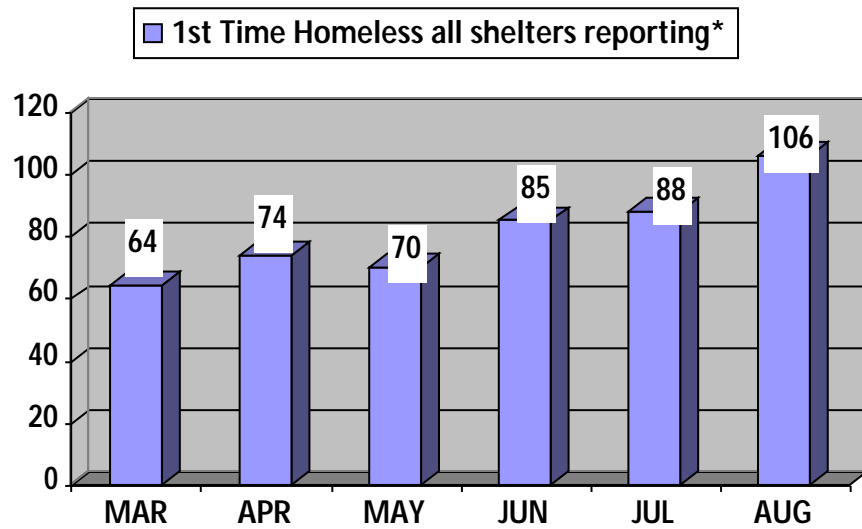

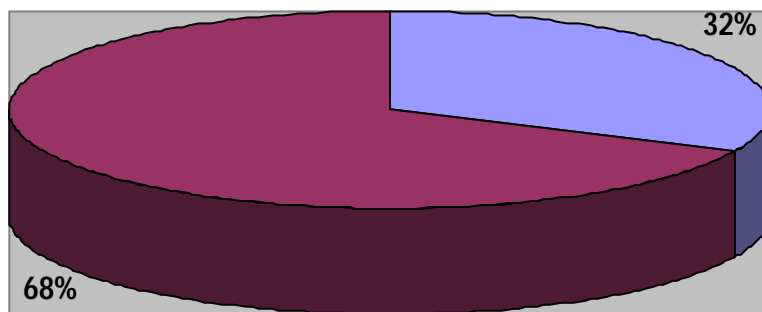

Percentage of Intakes

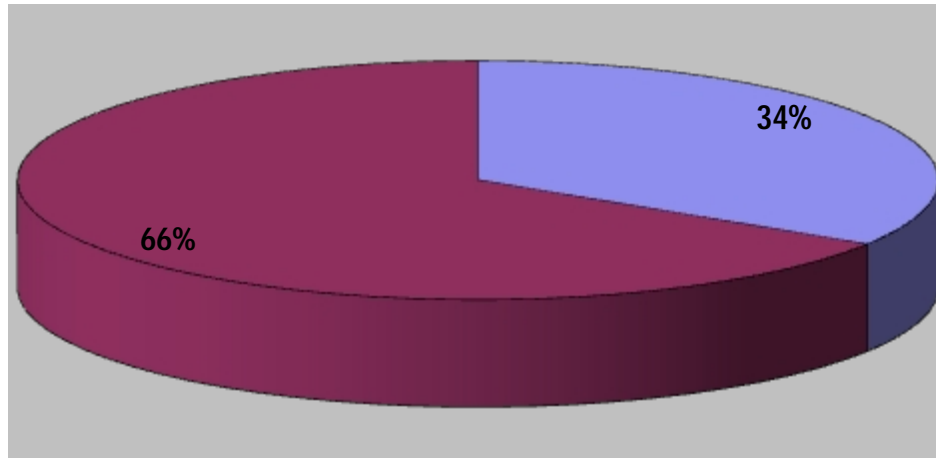
