Project Description: The City of Portland's Water Resources Department is pursuing the sewer main replacement on Powland Street and Mitton Street. This replacement is being executed due to the unsuitable conditions of the existing sewer line. By executing this project, the sanitary sewer's overflow will be reduced.

The project will consist primarily of the replacement of the sewer main line in Powland Street and Mitton Street. Replacement of the sewer service laterals will also be executed in the scope of this project.

Other applications of construction in the area include Portland Water District's plan to replace the existing water lines on Powland and Mitton Street.

Finally, the roadway configuration will be restored by the removal and replacement of the pavement with 2" of base and 1.5" of surface at the end of the project. There will be no box cutting done on either street.

The project is slated for bidding in August 2017 with construction anticipated to begin September 2017.
