# City of Portland Bench Donation Policy

Location of all donated furnishings and language used on recognition plaques are subject to approval by Portland Parks Division.

As a tax-deductible donation, donated benches are property of Portland Parks Division, and will be maintained according to Portland Parks Division policy and priorities.

Bench donation terms are 15 years. After that period, the donated bench will be available for renewal for the cost of a new donation with the right of first refusal given to the original donor. If the original donor opts not to renew, the donated bench and plaque may be removed or rededicated at any time.

Portland Parks Division retains the right to relocate a donated bench at any time. If a bench needs to be relocated, the Division will attempt to contact the donor to discuss alternative locations; the Division will make the final determination.

The donation cost includes bench, shipping, installation, and memorial plaque. Please contact us at 207-797-4597 with questions on any park, open space, or trail location not listed.
