**ORDER AMENDING ORDER 257-20/21**  
**FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 APPROPRIATION RESOLVE**

**RESOLVED**, that the sum of **\$268,216,301** is hereby appropriated for Fiscal Year 2022 for General Municipal purposes; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the sum of ~~\$125,154,700~~ \$126,454,700 is hereby appropriated for Fiscal Year 2022 for School purposes; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Assessor of Taxes of the City of Portland be and hereby is directed to assess a tax upon all real estate liable to be taxed therein and to assess the owner of, or such other persons as may be liable by law for, personal property liable to be taxed therein on the first day of April, 2021 and not exempt from taxation, to the aggregate amount of \$91,014,931 for municipal purposes and ~~\$100,582,406~~ \$99,083,251 for school purposes for a total tax levy of ~~\$191,597,337~~ 190,098,182 for Fiscal Year 2022, in accordance with the provisions of the Statutes of Maine; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, all taxes assessed as above and committed to the Director of Finance shall be due 30 days after the City's Tax Commitment 2021, and payable in two equal installments, the first due 30 days after the City's Tax Commitment 2021, and the second installment due on the 18th day of March, 2022. The delinquency rate of interest shall be six percent (6%) per annum on all payments received after the respective due dates and the abatement rate of interest shall be two percent (2%) per annum.
