**ORDER DECLARING JUNE 30, 2021 TO NOVEMBER 1, 2021
THE OUTDOOR DINING/RETAIL FESTIVAL**

ORDERED, that June 30, 2021 to November 1, 2021 is hereby declared to be the Outdoor Dining/Retail Festival, sponsored by the City of Portland; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that in accordance with Portland City Code Chapter 19, section 19-22, the Outdoor Dining/Retail Festival area shall be as follows:

The area occupied as of the effective date of this order pursuant to, and in compliance with, all Temporary Outdoor Dining Permits and/or Temporary Sidewalk/Street Sale Permits issued to licensees who submitted an application for such permits on or before May 10, 2021 and were subsequently granted such permits (collectively “the Licensees”); and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that, notwithstanding other provisions of the City Code, Licensees are hereby authorized to continue to occupy the Festival Zone area, including on City sidewalks, parks, or in privately owned parking lots in accordance with their respective licenses and temporary rules and regulations adopted by the Department of Permitting and Inspections; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that notwithstanding Chapter 25 or other provisions of the City Code, the fees for occupying a parklet shall be as charged to the Licensees for the 2021 season and no additional fees shall be due for existing licenses held by Licensees; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the following streets shall be closed in accordance with the provisions of this order, and as further detailed by the City Manager:

1. Milk Street between Exchanges Street and Market Street;
2. Wharf Street between Moulton Street and Union Street;
3. Dana Street between Fore Street and Commercial Street;
4. The Eastbound side of Fore Street between Silver Street and Pearl Street; and

5. The Eastbound lane of Middle Street from Franklin Street to India Street; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that notwithstanding other provisions of the City Code, Licensees holding a Temporary Sidewalk/Street Sale Permit authorizing outdoor display and sale of retail items in accordance with temporary rules and regulations adopted by the Department of Permitting and Inspections are hereby authorized to continue to display and sell retail items for the duration of this order; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that access required under the Americans with Disabilities Act shall be maintained.
