

Snow Ban Parking Locations

NOTE:

There are a number of places people can park at no charge during a parking ban including:

1. Deering Oaks – on the left hand side of Tennis Court Road only
2. State Street gravel lot – abutting Deering oaks
3. Fitzpatrick Stadium parking lot; parking behind the Ice Arena only. No parking adjacent to the Arena
4. Hadlock Field parking lot
5. All Portland Public School lots EXCEPT the lots at Reiche School which abut the school and playground and Adult Ed at the former Cathedral lot
 -Amanda C. Rowe Elementary School (formaly Hall School) parking
 lot and road to parking is under the work to be updated for the map. Following restrictions apply at Rowe School.
 -- No parking anywhere on the bus loop
 -- No parking out back off Purchas Street which is the shipping, receiving and emergency access to the school.
 -- Parking is allowed in designated parking spaces only. NOT on the entrance road or the loop around the parking lot.
6. Cutter Street lots (off the Eastern Prom)
7. Eastern Promenade Street (From Turner St. to School Building on water side of street ONLY)
8. Marginal Way on Interstate Side of the Street ONLY (From Plowman St. to the Interstate Underpass)
9. Beach Street lot accessible from Commercial Street. (Available after 8 pm)
10. Angelos Acres Lot across the street from the International Marine Terminal on Commercial Street (corner of Park and Commercial Streets)
11. On Peaks Island, parking is available at the Welch Street parking lot and St. Christopher's Church parking lot on Central Avenue
12. Western Promenade-Entir waterside (From Bramhall St. to Vaughan St. plus in the turn out)
13. Many parking garages in the area are open for parking bans at reduced rates – check with individual garages for rates and hours.
14. Preble Street Extension Parking Lot (Across from Hannaford) - adhere to the spaces that are designated for snow ban parking.
15. State Street Extension - Parking is available on State St Ext between Forest Ave & Park Ave across from the entrance to Deering Oaks Park. Left side of the road only where parking is typically available. Adhere to any no parking signs closest to Forest Ave.
