**AMENDMENT TO PORTLAND CITY CODE**

**CHAPTER 5 (ANIMALS & FOWL)**

**ARTICLE VI. Keeping of Domesticated Chickens, SECTION 401(b)**

**RE: Chicken Permit Annual Fee**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND,  
MAINE IN CITY COUNCIL ASSEMBLED AS FOLLOWS:**

*1. That Article IV., Chapter 5, section 401(b), is hereby  
amended to read as follows:*

**Sec. 5-401. Permit required.**

(a) An annual permit is required for the keeping of any domesticated chickens. The annual permit is personal to the permittee and may not be assigned.

(b) The fee for an annual permit to keep chickens is  
| twenty-~~five~~six dollars (\$256.00).

(c) An applicant for a permit to keep chickens must demonstrate compliance with the criteria and standards in this Article in order to obtain a permit.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED,** that this amendment is enacted as an Emergency, pursuant to Article II, Section 11 of the Portland City Charter, in order to make it effective on July 5, 2015.
