Freestyle Ice Sessions: **Effective Tuesday, September 8<sup>th</sup>**

1. Online registration is now **MANDATORY** for all public freestyle and freestyle ice sessions. Please go to [Portland Recreation's Community Pass Website](#) to register for sessions. If you need help registering, please call 207-808-5491. Online registration will be available on September 5<sup>th</sup>. **MAXIMUM SKATERS ALLOWED: 25**
2. Skaters must be pre-registered at least 1 hour **BEFORE** the session start time. There are **NO exceptions** to this rule.
3. **ONLY sessions canceled 8 hours PRIOR to session start time are eligible to receive a credit or refund. To cancel, please email [vla@portlandmaine.gov](mailto:vla@portlandmaine.gov) or 207-808-5491.**
4. Skaters are **required** to wear a face covering (*shields alone are not acceptable per the CDC*) inside the rink. During skating activities, face coverings are encouraged but not required.
5. We will require each participant to answer a series of screening questions regarding symptoms of Covid-19. We will also require all participants to take a thermal temperature check. If anyone answers "yes" to any of the questions or has a temperature above 100.4 Fahrenheit, they will not be allowed to participate. Individuals experiencing a fever, cough, or ANY other symptoms consistent with COVID-19 are prohibited from entering the arena.
6. Plan to arrive at the rink no more than 10 minutes before your scheduled program. This allows staff to limit the number of people allowed in the arena.
7. Skaters are to be dropped off/picked up outside the rink. There will be **no** spectators allowed in the arena. Very young children can be briefly accompanied by **one** adult for assistance prior to and immediately following their session. Any adult accompanying participants will also be required to take a thermal temperature check. If anyone answers "yes" to any of the questions or has a temperature above 100.4 Fahrenheit, they will not be allowed in the building. Individuals experiencing a fever, cough, or ANY other symptoms consistent with COVID-19 are prohibited from entering the arena as well.
8. Skaters must exit the building within 10 minutes after their session has concluded.
9. ***Please follow the green arrows upon entering the rink and the red arrows upon exiting the rink.***

Public Freestyle Sessions (*Must be Gamma level of higher*): **Effective September 10<sup>th</sup>, Every Thursday from 12:00 – 1:30 p.m.**
