The City of Portland receives approximately \$2.1 million annually of federal funding from the Department of Housing and Urban Development in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). Their job is to research possible emerging urban planning, public improvement and social service needs. They will analyze, deliberate, debate, and finally make recommendations as to the most pressing needs facing our City.
