

## SCHOOL RELATED VOTES

- 12/10/09: **Include language in the charter on duties to include “sound fiscal management” passes 11-1 (Ranaghan)**  
*See Article III, Section 4.*
- 12/10/09: **Have parallel budget language to that in charter for the Manager, passes 12-0**  
*See Article III, Section 5, third paragraph*
- 12/10/09: **Have broad statement that speaks to requirement for joint meetings prior to delivery of the budget to the City; passes 11-1 (Ranaghan)**  
*See Article III, Section 5, second paragraph.*
- 12/10/09: **Having parity in compensation between city and school committee passes 11-1 (Ranaghan)**  
*See Article III, Section 1, last paragraph.*
- 12/10/09: **Change of name to Board of Public Education passes 7-5 (Ranaghan, Mermin, Valleau, Plumb, Chipman)**  
*See Article I, Section 2 and throughout the text*
- 03/18/10: **The council shall provide for such additional compensation to the chair of the school committee as is appropriate to reflect the additional responsibilities of that job, passes 9-1 (Ranaghan).**  
*See Article III, Section 1, last paragraph*
- 03/18/10: **Motion that language be included in charter to require annually that the Chair of Board of Public Education address the city council regarding the state of the school system passes 9-1 (Valleau)**  
*See Article III, Section 2, last paragraph*
- 03/18/10: **Motion that a subset of the Commission be designated by the chair to look at developing information and come back to the Commission with information and recommendation (re: Improving coordination of council and school committee areas of shared responsibility, i.e. Finance, MIS and Human Resources) passes 10-0.**

*4/8/10: No motion made to consolidate Finance functions. Possible general language re: coordination of functions pending.*
