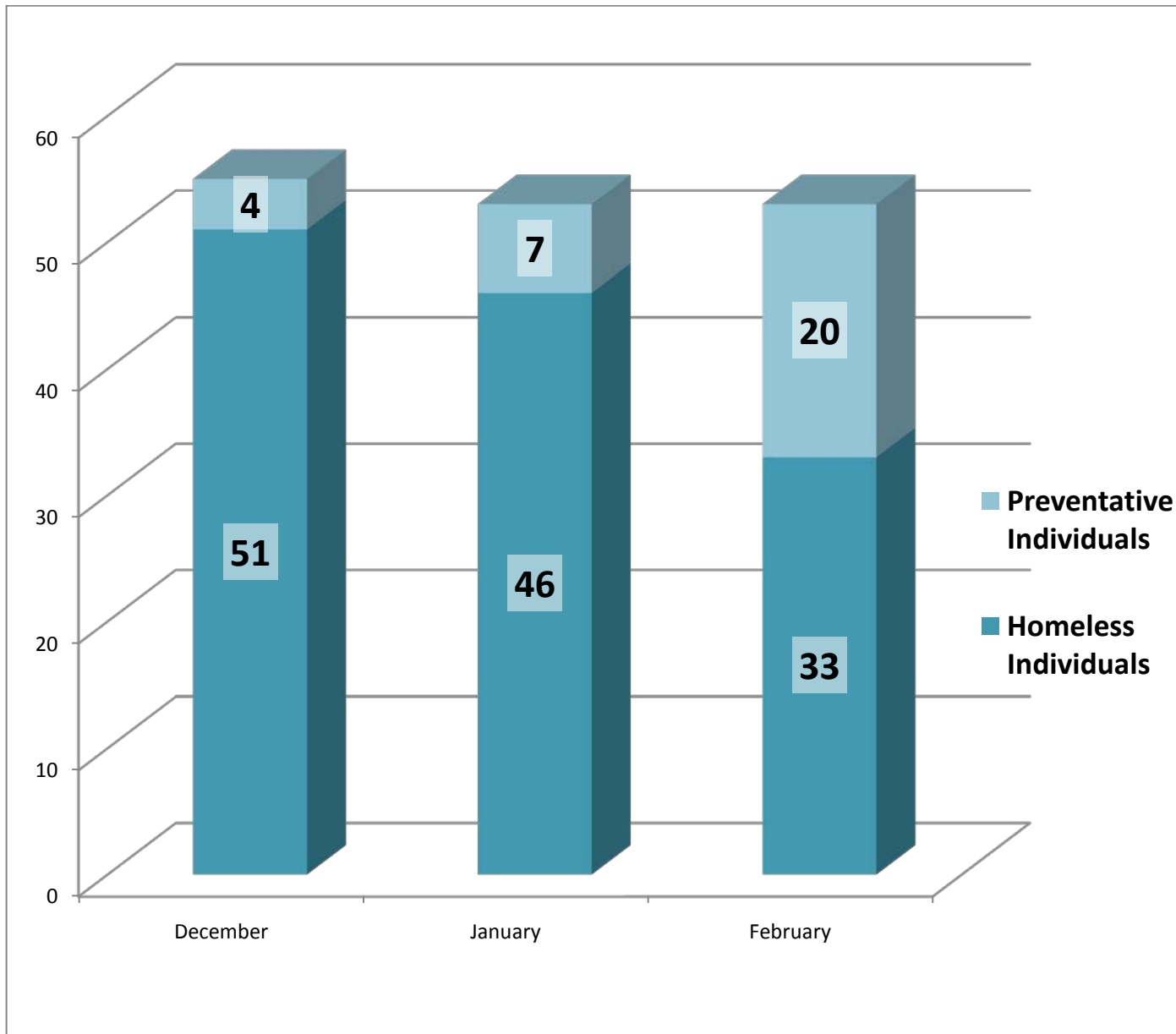
Total Housing Placements (Homeless & Preventative Clients)

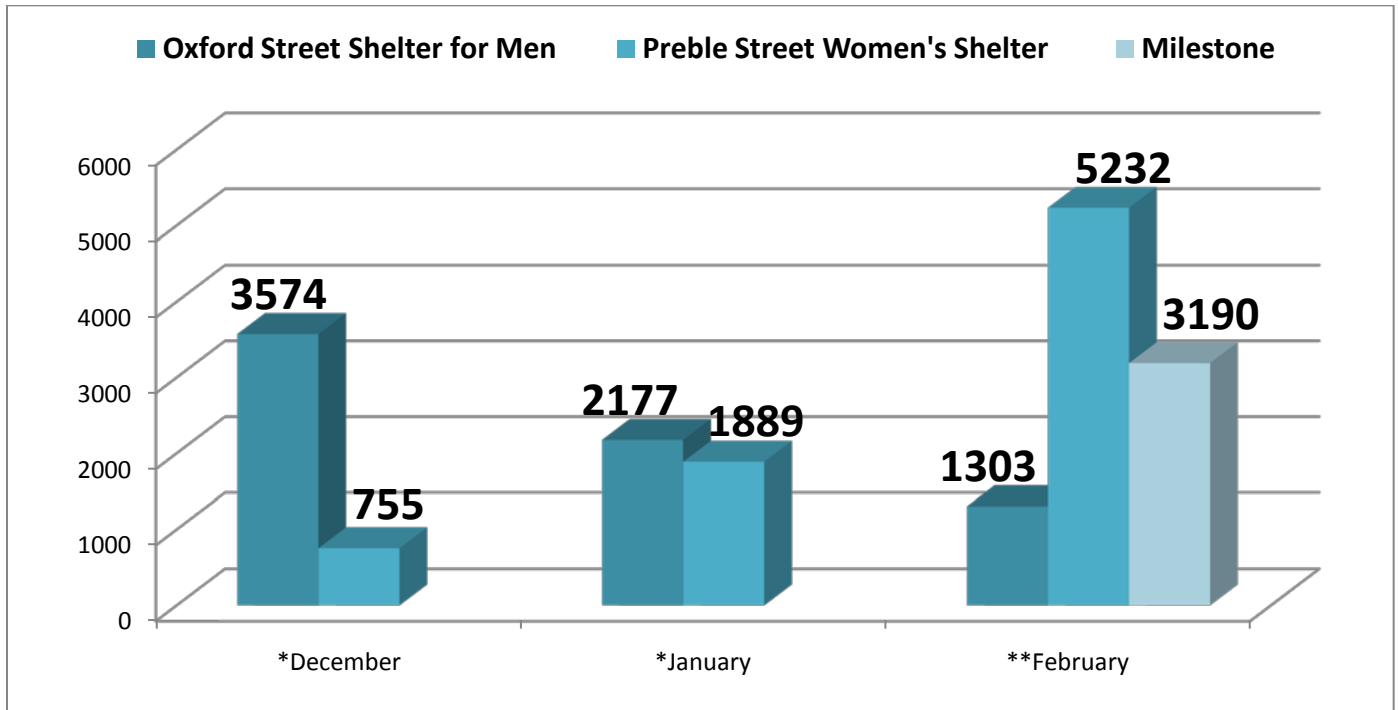

## Total Bed Nights Used by Homeless Housed Clients

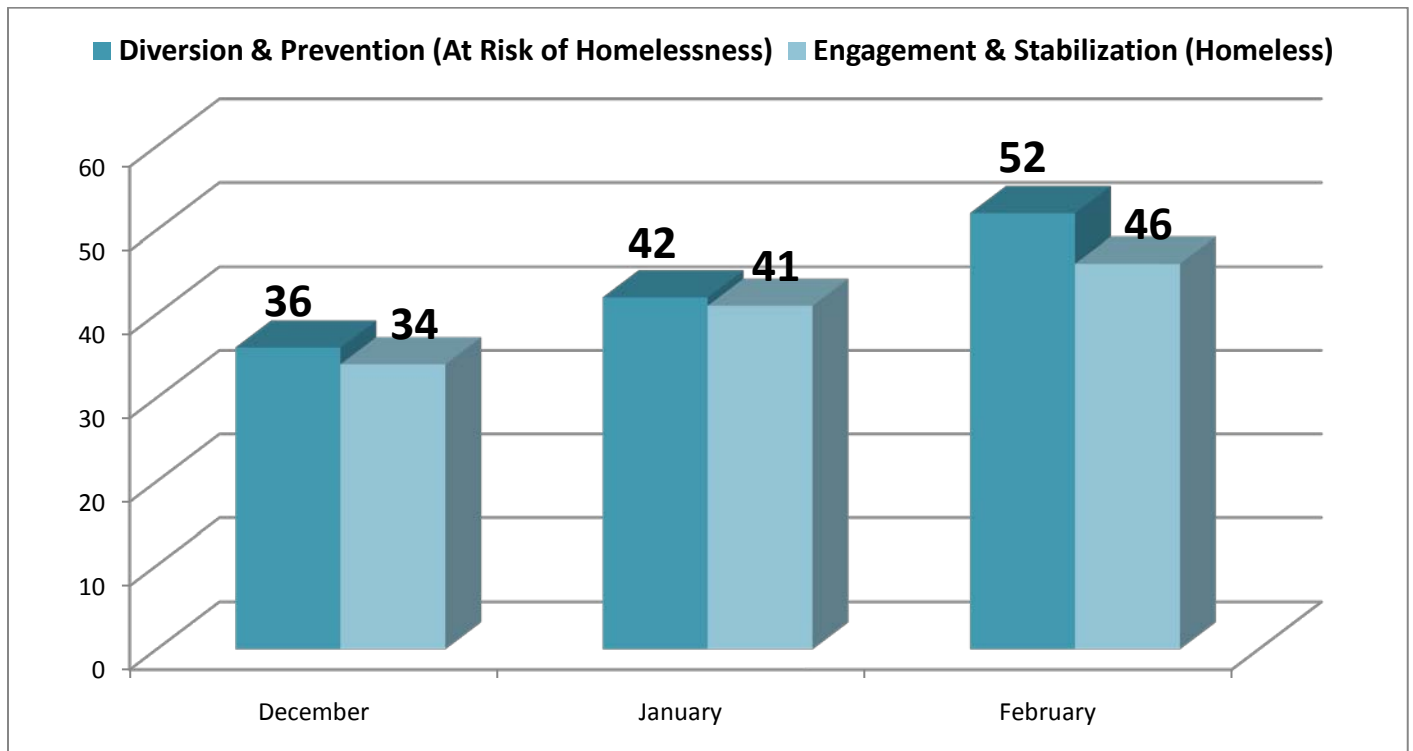

### Household Enrollment by Program



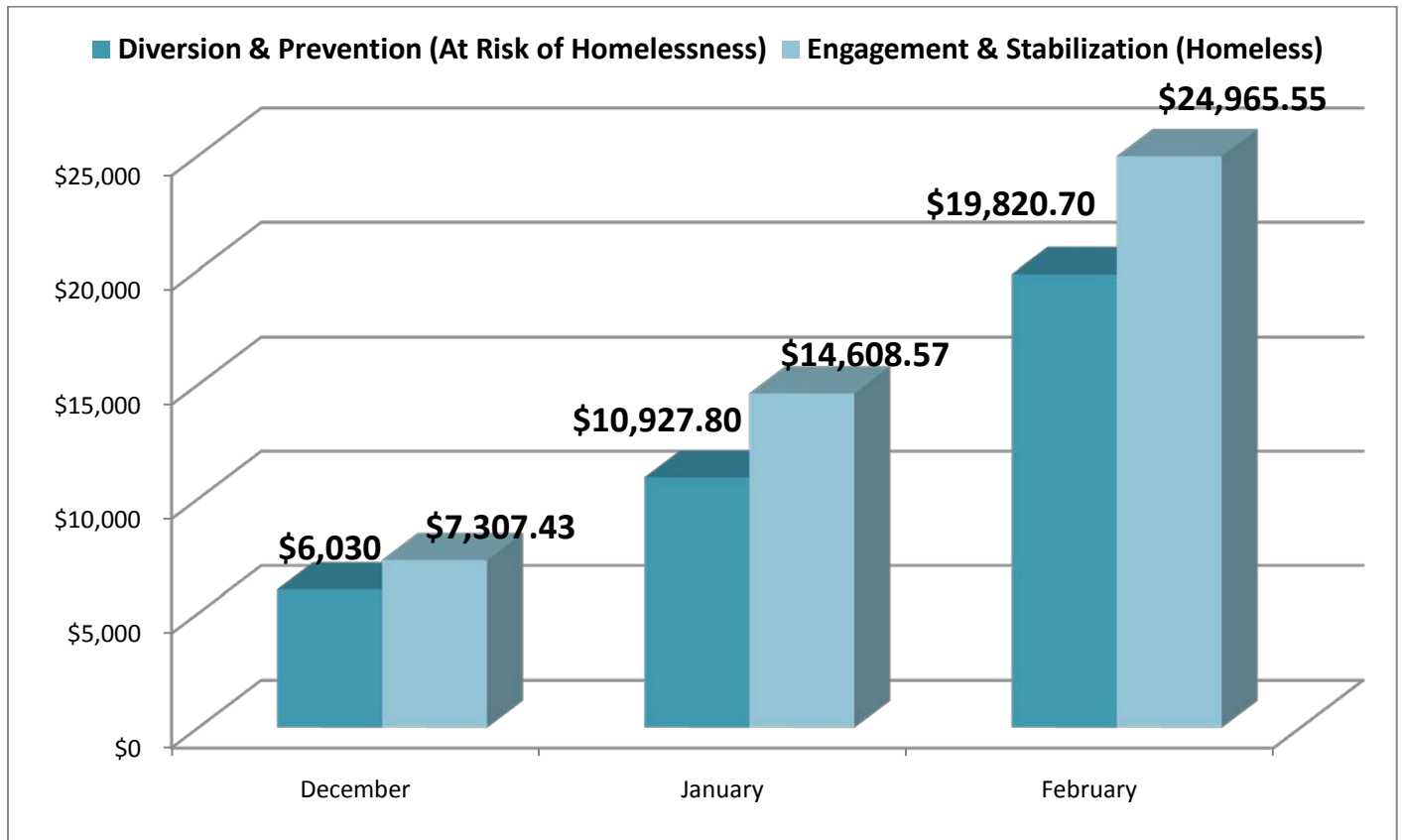
Represents the number of households enrolled by program, not individuals
