Boat Trailer Parking Permits

2021 SEASON

Dear Mooring Permit Holders,

As a mooring permit holder, if you **use a boat trailer** and need to park in the designated trailer spots at the East End boat launch parking lots, you must contact the city of Portland Parks, Recreation, and Facilities office to obtain a season pass for your trailer.

To acquire a season pass for your trailer, please fill out a season pass application and contact the Portland Parks, Recreation, and Facilities office with your request. Please use the link below to get to the season pass application. Call our office with any questions.

Season Pass Fees: *Resident \$50 Non-Resident \$100*

Please note:

- Those trailers not properly displaying a season pass for the East End lot off of Cutter Street will receive a parking ticket that the owner is responsible to pay
- If you park your vehicle without a trailer, you must use a regular passenger car spot; you will not need a sticker for your vehicle
- There is **no** overnight parking in the Cutter Street parking lots
