Stevens Avenue Improvements

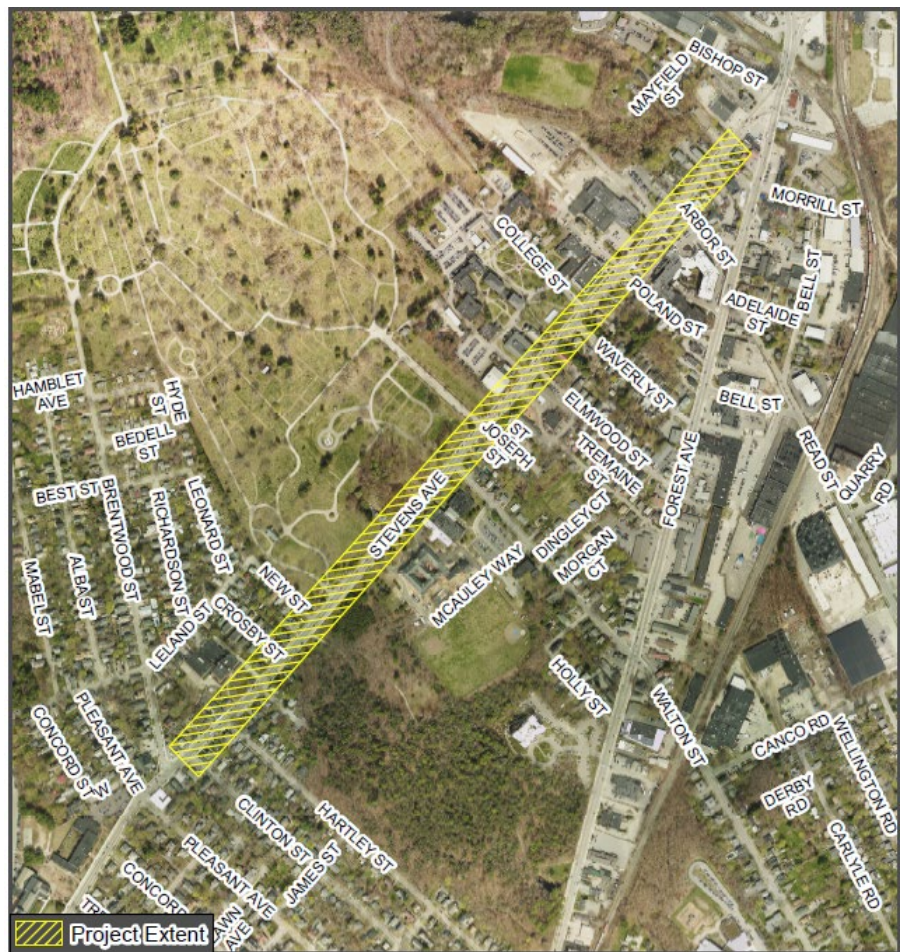
Project Description: This project is the Stevens Avenue Improvement project which is a MaineDOT Municipal Partnership Initiative (MPI) Paving Project.

The goal of project is to improve Stevens Avenue from Pleasant Avenue to Forest Avenue in the City of Portland. Preservation and extension of the useful life of this road is a main goal.

The project includes a 2” mill and fill, new stormwater/drainage improvements, sidewalk and curb repair, improvements to curb ramps to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), and final striping incorporating new bike lanes after paving is completed.

The project is currently at Purchasing and we are expecting a bid date sometime in May/June 2021.

We anticipate construction to start shortly after bidding is complete and the project is awarded.
